Power Ranges and Progressive Lens Details

Power ranges: plus or minus 4.00 sphere and minus 3.00 cylinder. Additional powers are available at \$1.50 per diopter.

Progressive lenses: Silver is available in 16 mm and 19 mm. Gold is available in 15 mm, 17 mm, and 19 mm.

Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Affordable Vision Package?

The Affordable Vision Package, or AVP, is a built-in, private-pay complete pair package program. It is available to providers who need a low-cost option for their patients.

What frames can be used for an AVP order?

Available inventory includes frames from the FGX Lantis Collection, Modern Optical Metals, Modern Optical Plastic I and II collections, and additional eligible frame collections. Providers should visit the Classic Optical website for the complete current frame list.

What are providers using the AVP for?

- Creating a frame-and-lens value package to offer patients.
- Providing an affordable option for Medicaid patients who have exhausted their eyeglass benefit but still need new eyeglasses.
- Supporting Managed Care Medicaid plans where providers are required to submit claims for hardware or eyeglass materials.
- Offering additional pair purchases, including polarized lenses, photochromic lenses, readers, second pairs, and single vision lenses for multifocal wearers who need task-specific eyewear.

How do I get more information or set up an account?

If you currently order online with Classic Optical, you are already set up to order AVP. If you do not have an online Classic Optical account, contact customer service at 888-522-2020.

What is included when the patient receives the order?

The patient receives a hard case, cleaning cloth, and maintenance tip sheet.

What happens if the patient does not receive the order?

- Provider offices receive an email with tracking information for each order.
- The patient must report any order not received within 10 days to the provider's office.
- The provider's office must contact Classic Optical customer service at 888-522-2020 to report the issue.
